What is May Crowning?

"And a great portent appeared in heaven, a woman clothed with the sun, with the moon under her feet, and on her head a crown of twelve stars" (Rev 12:1)

It is a feast recognizing Mary as queen of heaven and earth!
In the tradition of the Catholic church we crown Our Lady with flowers in the month of May.

Here is a template your family can use to crown Mary in your own home.

You can use a homemade crown of flowers with your household Mary statue

or a printed bouquet/Mary statue!



To Begin...

As a family, prepare your hearts to crown Mary. Line up in age order with one child chosen as the *crowner*.

Process into the room, where your statue or image of Mary is, while singing

Holy Mary Now We Crown You (link) or a sung Hail Mary.

On this day we sing your praises, Purest Maid of all the earth; While the beauty of the springtime Tells your joy at Jesus' birth.

Stain of sin has never marred you, Mankind's only spotless bloom: God, whose might exceeds the heavens, You have sheltered in your womb.

Glorious Queen, look down in kindness While before your throne we stand: Bring God's blessing to your children; Watch our homes and guard our land.

Gate of Heaven, you were Mother To the King of heav'n and earth: Now be Mother to your subjects, In our souls give Jesus birth.

Queen of Mankind, while creation Speaks the grandeur of God's love, Mold our hearts to seek his glory Till we reach our home above.

(Here crown Mary)

Holy Mary, now we crown you Honored Queen of all our race: Noble Virgin, may our tribute Win your love and gain us grace. Hail Mary, full of Grace
The Lord is with thee
Blessed art thou among women
And blessed is the fruit of thy womb, Jesus
Holy Mary, Mother of God
Pray for us sinners now,
And at the hour of our death

Amen (Here crown Mary)





When Mary is crowned and all are standing or kneeling around Mary, say the Litany of the Blessed Virgin Mary.

Choose a parent or eldest child to lead.

Lord, have mercy on us. Christ, have mercy on us. Lord, have mercy on us.

Christ, hear us. Christ, graciously hear us. (Leader say title and all respond: Have Mercy on us)

God the Father of Heaven, Have mercy on us. God the Son, Redeemer of the world, Have mercy on us.

God the Holy Ghost, Have mercy on us. Holy Trinity, one God, Have mercy on us. These Titles of Mary were created by the 2nd graders of St. Croix Catholic School
