(Rain date - Friday, October 26th)

Third and Fourth grade students will perform fall clean-up and light maintenance at the tri-parish St. Michael's Cemetery in Bayport. Students will work in small groups to beautify the grounds by either picking up sticks and other debris or edging around headstones with putty or butter knives.

On Wednesday, October 17th, Father Juettner will visit the third and fourth graders after Mass to express how important their work is and present the history of the St. Michael's Cemetery. On Tuesday, October 23rd, Father Juettner will greet the children as they arrive at the cemetery and lead them in a prayer before starting their service project.

The bus will arrive at school to take the students to the cemetery at 1:30. All students will be back at school by 3:15. **Please complete and return the attached bus permission slip by Monday, October 15th.**

As a result of extremely dirty hands from past years, we will be supplying the children with latex free disposable gloves as they do their work. If you would like to send your own garden/work gloves with your child, please do so. **Due to the outdoor nature of the work students will be allowed to wear spirit wear, faith rally shirts and jeans, otherwise they must be in their uniforms.**

Parents are needed and encouraged to volunteer to supervise the children at the cemetery. We ask that **parent volunteers drive themselves** to the cemetery and meet the students at the **north side entrance**. Please let us know if you are planning to volunteer by returning the lower portion of this page to your child's teacher by **Monday, October 15th**.
